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Minutes of the North Logan City **Planning Commission** Held on May 6, 2010 At the North Logan City Library, North Logan, Utah

The meeting was called to order by Mark Hancey at 7:03 p.m.

Commission members present were: Mike McGrath, Geri Christensen, Frank Prince, Bob Balling and Mark Hancey. (Glen Hansen was excused)

Others present were: Jake Young, Kris Bown, Barbara Middleton, Allen Kartchner, Trisha Northcutt, John Worley, Niki Walker, Cordell Batt and Marie Wilhelm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Bob Balling. An invocation was given by Geri Christensen.

Adoption of Agenda Per a question from Mark Hancey regarding electing a Vice-Chair, Cordell Batt said that will likely take place at the next meeting.

Bob Balling made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Geri Christensen seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously.

Approval and Follow-up of Minutes for April 8, 2010 Planning Commission Meeting Bob Balling made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Geri Christensen seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously.

Follow-up Cordell Batt mentioned the information he gave to the Planning Commission reminding them about the upcoming Cache County Citizen's Planner training taking place on Thursday. May 20th at 11:30 a.m. The Planning Commission discussed this briefly; and Cordell said that he got a resource book from a prior training that he will get permission to give copies of to the Planning Commission members.

New Business

Consideration and possible recommendation for an ordinance amending Title 12-C - Land Use. Zoning Ordinance of the City's Code of Revised Ordinances amending the zoning matrix included therein by adding "Heliport" as a Conditional Use in the Hospital Zone.

Cordell explained the proposal for changing the code and discussed Cache Valley Specialty Hospital's desire to have a heliport at their facility. He reviewed some of the information that was in the packet given to the Planning Commission.

John Worley, CEO from Cache Valley Specialty Hospital, shared a history of the situation and outlined what they wanted to accomplish at the hospital. He also explained that when the hospital was initially built, there was no intention of having an emergency room (ER); but that when they wanted to get licensed as a "hospital" and not as a surgical-facility only, the state of Utah required, among other things, that the hospital have a 24 hour, seven-days-a-week ER. He said as they have really grown as a hospital, they have become concerned about providing a better level of service to the community, and further described the need for a heliport in relation to providing more and higher quality care to this area.

Geri Christensen said that she lives in the area and discussed her feelings and support for this request.

John Worley discussed additional details with the Planning Commission.

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Per a question from the Planning Commission regarding potential conflicts with neighbors, and 57 the adjacent Greenville Elementary School, Mr. Worley said he received a letter from Dee 58 Ashcroft, Principal of Greenville, stating that the chance of having a problem with the helicopters 59 is less than the need there may be for a child needing to be heliported out of their school in an 60 emergency. 61 Cordell said that staff does not have a concern about the use in this specific zone; and also 62 discussed the public noticing process for this potential code change. 63 64 Bob Balling made a motion to pass this on to the City Council with a positive recommendation. 65 Geri Christensen seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously. 66 67 Presentation to Planning Commission about developing a Formed-Based Code for North Logan 68 69 City. Cordell Batt introduced Jake Young, local planner and landscape architect, and said he would be 70 giving a presentation on "form-based" codes. Cordell said he needs to know from the Planning 71 Commission, whether this is something they want to pursue. He said the city of Logan is redoing 72 their entire code system to do form-based codes, and are almost done with that. 73 74 Jake Young proceeded to explain and define form-based codes, the benefits of such, and how 75 our City could apply and benefit from using them. 76 The Planning Commission discussed various aspects of this. 77 Geri Christensen said she is very much in support of this and would love to see this in North 78 79 Logan. Mark Hancey said that in establishing these forms, cities have to be careful about making 80 everything the "same for everyone", and being sure to consider the different desires of the various 81 property owners. 82 Cordell said public input on this is very important. He said there is still a lot of property that can 83 be developed; and that it needs to be done carefully, and should be something very nice. 84 Cordell mentioned that City Council member John Bailey went to a presentation regarding this 85 issue and that he wanted this presented before the City Council. Cordell said he and John Bailey 86 suggested putting a little bit of funding in the Planning budget to start this process. 87 88 Set Next Agenda and/or Discussion 89 Cordell said a Planning Commission meeting will likely not be held in two weeks, but rather not 90 91 until the first week of June. 92 Geri Christensen made a motion to elect Glen Hansen as Vice Chair for the Planning 93 Commission. Bob Balling seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed 94 95 unanimously. 96 Frank Prince made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Bob Balling seconded the motion.
