Minutes of the North Logan City 1 **Planning Commission** 2 Held on March 17, 2011 3 At the North Logan City Library, North Logan, Utah 4 5 6 7 8 The meeting was called to order by Glen Hansen at 7:00 p.m. 9 Commission members present were: Glen Hansen, Mike McGrath, Bob Balling, Geri Christensen 10 and Frank Prince. (Mark Hancey was excused.) 11 12 Others present were: Emily Pannell Johnson, Roxanne Gibbons, Jay Baker, Lydia Embry, 13 14 Cordell Batt and Marie Wilhelm. 15 16 The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Geri Christensen. An invocation was given by Frank Prince. 17 18 Adoption of Agenda 19 Mike McGrath made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Bob Balling seconded the 20 motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously. 21 22 Approval and Follow-up of Minutes for February 17, 2011 Planning Commission Meeting 23 Bob Balling made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Mike McGrath seconded the 24 motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously. 25 26 27 Follow-up 28 Nothing at this time. 29 30 **New Business** 31 Consideration of the Development Plan and Preliminary Plat for a two (2) lot subdivision (North Logan Library Subdivision) in the R-1-12 zone located at approximately 475 East 2500 North, 32 North Logan. (North Logan City). 33 Cordell Batt presented this item. He said the City Council had approved the conceptual plan. He 34 explained that the parcel is being split into two lots, and oriented those in attendance to the site 35 and to the preliminary plat. He said lot one will be 1.4 acres, and lot two will be the remaining 36 parcel. He explained the shared access with the Library, as well as which reports will be waived, 37 and which ones required, per the staff report. 38 Cordell Batt continued to explain various items to the Planning Commission. He explained that 39 there is a right-of-way for the future 600 East that will eventually go through and tie into the Hyde 40 Park road that ties in from the north. Cordell detailed more from the staff report and said that staff 41 recommends a positive recommendation on the development plan and the preliminary plat. He 42 also said that Jeff Jorgensen is working with the irrigation company on the water shares and that 43 44

they will put together a note that will be on the plat before it is signed and approved. He said one 45 share will go with lot one and the remaining shares with lot two.

The Planning Commission continued to briefly discuss various items including access and landscaping.

Geri Christensen made a motion to make a positive recommendation to the City Council, including recommendations made by staff in the report. Frank Prince seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously.

7:15 pm Public Hearing and possible consideration of a Conditional Use Permit for an 53 accessory dwelling located at 1089 East 2100 North, North Logan (R-1-10 Zoning) (Wally and 54 55 Roxanne Gibbons). 56 Cordell Batt explained the situation and oriented those in attendance to the location via an overhead aerial map, as well as street photos, of the site. He said an inspection was done that 57 day and there were a few very minor things for the owners to take care of, but said the inspector 58 approved it as an accessory dwelling. He said before the City sends a final approval letter to the 59 owners, they are requiring a notarized letter from the owners stating that they will be living in the 60 home, as that is one of the stipulations. Cordell Batt further outlined the requirements listed in the 61 staff report. Cordell said he would ensure that all the requirements are finished before the final 62 63 approval letter is sent out. The Planning Commission discussed various minor issues. 64 65 Glen Hansen opened the public hearing at 7:26 p.m., and as there were no public comments, 66 closed the public hearing at 7:27 p.m. 67 68 Frank Prince made a motion to approve the conditional use permit, including the requirements 69 made by staff. Geri Christensen seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed 70 unanimously. 71 72 Planning Commission Training Session by Jay Baker (Cache County-wide Planner). 73 Jay Baker gave his presentation to the Planning Commission on the Powers, Duties and Authority of the Planning Commission and Appeal Authority, utilizing PowerPoint. 74 75 76 Set Next Agenda and/or Discussion Cordell Batt said we don't have anything for the next Planning Commission meeting. He said a 77 mixed use project may come in, which can be discussed at the meeting the second week in April. 78 79 80 81 Bob Balling made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mike McGrath seconded the motion. A vote 82 was called and the motion passed unanimously. 83 84 The meeting adjourned at: 8:42 p.m. 85 86
